ORDER CLOSING CASE AND DISMISSING WITHOUT PREJUDICE

THIS CAUSE comes before the Court upon the Joint Stipulation of Dismissal without Prejudice, filed on June 25, 2026 [ECF No. 11]. Pursuant to Rule 41(a)(1)(A)(ii), the Stipulation of Dismissal, signed by all parties who have appeared, is self-executing and dismisses the case “effective immediately upon filing.” *See Anago Franchising, Inc. v. Shaz, LLC*, 677 F.3d 1272, 1277 (11th Cir. 2012).
